What does it mean to live life on mission? Pastor Leland Crawford preached on the Good Samaritan two weeks ago and the Women at the Well last week. Mike Jackson, our Sunday School teacher, teaches the same passages in Sunday School. Bro. Charlie Lechner has First Baptist Minden reading through the book of James every week throughout the month of January looking for different truths each week. Everything our ministers are doing at First Baptist is designed to get us outside of the church looking for people to serve.

This past week after those lessons, I was confronted with two "down and outs". First, with a drug addict that was stranded in Minden looking for a warm place to sleep. The second time we were confronted with a "Women at the Well" who needed a ride back home, nearly to Junction City, Arkansas, after being stranded in Minden. I kiddingly chided my pastor saying that it would have been easier to walk past these two "down and outs" if only he and Mike and Charlie would stop preaching and teaching the Bible! But because the Word convicts and is so clear about Christian service, we could not walk by them. Was it convenient to minister to them? No! It cost us money, time, and several hours of ministry. Yet, the Word is clear on what we were supposed to do. Following Christ can be messy. Following Christ can be sacrificial. But, if we profess to be a follower of Christ we must be willing to take up our cross in sacrificial service. Question? What would your church look like if everyone truly followed Christ in sacrificial service? How would that impact your community? How would that change your life?

James 2:15-17 is that thorny passage about faith and works being two sides of the same coin. If you say you have faith yet refuse to help those without food and clothes, can we really say we have faith?

John 4 Jesus talks to the "Woman at the Well". He reached out to a despised Samaritan with shady character and gave her the water of life.

Luke 10:29-37 tells the story of the Good Samaritan. Who is my neighbor? What must I do to show that I am a Christian neighbor? What about those convicting words of Jesus found in verse 37? "Go and do likewise!"

We have begun a new year. Are we going to idle away the year separating ourselves from the lonely, despised, messed up, and lost neighbors around us, or will we engage them in ministry representing Christ? I challenge you to personally and cooperatively with your church engage your community to share Christ through word and deed. I believe 2023 will look a lot different from 2022 if we do so. February's theme is love, let's love in deed as well as words.
