Letter from our Associational Missions Strategist, Jeff Hoffman

It reminds us of what the Bible says about the seasons. In Matthew 16:3 we find these words of Jesus..." You know how to interpret the appearance of the sky, but you cannot interpret the signs of the times." 
Christ in the Passover: A Presentation


